**RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE 2040 LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN**

*WHEREAS*, in accordance with the U.S. Census Bureau officially designated Urbanized Area Boundaries established May 1, 2002 and updated on November 1, 2012; and

*WHEREAS*, the Warner Robins Area Transportation Study has been designated by the Governor of Georgia as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Warner Robins Urbanized Area in accordance with Federal requirements of Title 23, Section 134 of the United States Code to have a Cooperative, Comprehensive and Continuous transportation planning process; and

*WHEREAS*, the Warner Robins Area Transportation Study, in accordance with federal requirements for a Long Range Transportation Plan, has developed a twenty-five-year integrated plan for federally-funded multimodal projects for the Warner Robins Urbanized Area; and

*WHEREAS*, the LRTP is consistent with all plans, goals and objectives of the Warner Robins Area Transportation Study, and shall be updated at least every five years with revisions to reflect changes in program emphasis and anticipated funding availability; and

*NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED*, that the Warner Robins Area Transportation Study Policy Committee adopts the 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan as required by Title 23 (USC 134 Section 450.308) and pursuant to the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Act (MAP-21).
