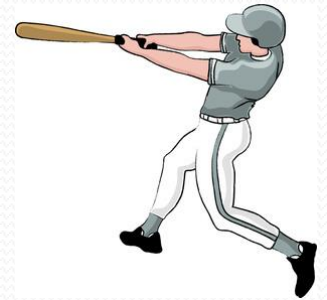

# Draft- Simpson Park



- Each child will receive a draft number
- Participants will execute basic drills- throwing, catching, fielding, & hitting
- Head coaches will return to the Draft Room to draft players
- EVERYONE will be drafted, regardless of ability. Players not present may not be drafted and will be assigned to a team
- Blastball & T-Ball will go through a computer draft in lieu of a skills assessment



# Coaches Meeting

- All coaches must pass a criminal background check in order to coach
- At the meeting, coaches will receive a packet with their roster, rules, etc, and will then contact you to let you know what team your child is on.
- Leagues should hear from a coach by February 28<sup>th</sup> .



# Equipment Issuing

- We will provide each child with a jersey and a cap (boys)/visor (girls)
- We will provide each *team* with:
  - 4 batting helmets
  - Full catcher's gear(8u and up)
  - Practice balls (all leagues)



# Equipment Issuing Continued

- Parents will need to provide:
  - Baseball- baseball pants and socks(team must match)
  - Softball- softball pants or shorts (team must match)
  - Blastball & T-Ball- baseball pants(team must match)
- No metal cleats (exception: Jr & Sr boys)
- All personal bats & batting helmets  
MUST be approved by our department  
before use



# Bats

- T-Ball(6U) T-Ball bat with USA Stamp (26” and shorter)
- 8U – 12U Barrel size up to 2 5/8 with USA Stamp(27” – 32”)
- 14U – 17U boys 2 5/8 barrel size bat, -3 drop, BBCOR(36” or less)
- Softball- Bat has to be a fast pitch bat
